## SENIOR LINE SUPERVISOR

- Develop management skills of subordinates by providing effective leadership, coaching, and setting clear objectives for achievement
- Ensure regulatory compliance and revise department policies and procedures as required; communicate changes to employees while adhering to current corporate policies.
